



Montserrat Martínez Parera Vice-Chair of the CNMV

Born in 1975 in Barcelona, Montserrat Martínez-Parera has a Degree in Economics and Business Science from Pompeu Fabra University and a Master's Degree in Economics and Finance from Center for Monetary and Financial Studies (CEMFI).

She became Vice-Chair of the Spanish Securities and Markets Commission (CNMV) in December 2020. She is also an ex-officio member of the Governing Committee of the Spanish Executive Resolution Authority (FROB), member of the Governing Board of the Banco de España and member of the Council and the Technical Committee of the Spanish Macroprudential Authority Financial Stability Board (AMCESFI).

Prior to her appointment as Vice-Chair of the CNMV, she was head of Public Affairs at CaixaBank and Director of the Chairman's Office. In June 2020, she was also appointed member of the Banking Stakeholder Group of the European Banking Authority (EBA).

From 2012 to 2017 she was Head of the Deputy Governor's office of the Banco de España. In 2012, she joined BBVA as vicepresident of the investor relations team at BBVA New York.

From 2007 to 2011 she was Director of the Chairman's Office at the Spanish Securities and Markets Commission (CNMV). She joined the CNMV in 2005 as a chief of staff to the Vice-Chair. She started her professional career at the Research Department at BBVA where she was senior economist.

Her field of interest are those related to the financial markets regulation and supervision and, in particular, prudential, resolution, consumer protection, sustainability and financial stability.
