Genevieve Helleringer is a permanent faculty member at ESSEC Business School in Paris and at Oxford University, a research member of the European Corporate Governance Institute and has been a recurrent visiting professor at UCLA. She is also an editor of the Journal of Financial Regulation (Oxford University Press) and the Oxford Business Law Blog. A qualified lawyer in France and the US, Genevieve practised in the corporate and financial market department of international law firms in New York and Paris before returning to work as an academic. Genevieve teaches topics that include financial regulation, M&A, corporate governance, with a comparative perspective and a strong emphasis on the European Law dimension. Genevieve also carries academic research, including behavioural studies, with a particular focus on the corporate governance of financial institutions, investor and financial consumer protection, the regulation of financial intermediaries, and financial and corporate sustainability.

Genevieve also frequently acts as a mediator, arbitrator and expert.

Genevieve is a Law graduate from Columbia University and Paris I Pantheon Sorbonne Law School. She also studied Economics & Management (ESSEC), Political Sciences (Sciences-Po Paris) and Experimental Psychology (Oxford University).
