Gergő Szeniczey

In May 2016, Mr. Gergő Szeniczey was promoted as Executive Director of Consumer Protection and Market Supervision in the Central Bank of Hungary (Magyar Nemzeti Bank - MNB). He is currently responsible for managing three directorates: Directorate for Consumer Protection, Directorate for Capital Markets and Market Supervision and the Financial Consumer Protection Center. He participates in several national and international organizations and is a Member of the Board of Supervisors of ESMA. Earlier he carried out duties as Director of the Market Supervision Directorate, when he also acted as the High-Level Alternate of MNB Vice-Governor Dr. Windisch in ESMA's BoS. His previous carrier in the institution started in January 2006, when Mr. Szeniczey joined the Hungarian Financial Supervisory Authority (HFSA) as Head of the Market Surveillance Department. He was responsible for market surveillance procedures related to market abuse cases and management of investigation units and also for the coordination of joint investigations, legal assistance in preventing market abuse on financial markets. Mr. Szeniczey represented the MNB in different ESMA standing committees and task forces: e.g. ESMA's Market Integrity Standing Committee – MISC (formerly CESR-Pol), CRA Technical Committee - CRA TC, Task Force on Legal Framework for Cooperation Arrangements and Information Exchange - LFTF. The duties of the HFSA were taken over by MNB in 2013, and in the new organization Mr. Szeniczey carried out duties as Head of Market Surveillance and Supervision Department. Before joining the HFSA Mr. Szeniczey gained a relevant market experience in different manager and compliance officer positions in the investment banking sector.
