# **DECISION OF THE MANAGEMENT BOARD**

## **Internal language arrangements**

#### The Management Board

**Having regard** to Article 73(2) of Regulation (EU) No 1095/2010 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 November 2010 establishing a European Supervisory Authority (European Securities and Markets Authority), amending Decision No 716/2009/EC and repealing Commission Decision 2009/77/EC<sup>1</sup> (the "Regulation" and "ESMA")

**Whereas** English is a language that is customary in the sphere of international finance and was the working language of the Committee of European Securities Regulators

Has adopted this decision:

#### Article 1 – Internal working language

The internal working language of ESMA is English.

### Article 2 – Entry into force

This decision enters into force immediately.
