

In addition, he underlined a forward-looking message based on the confidence that Europe's financial markets are better supported by an effective regulatory and supervisory system to face crisis situations.



ESMA's impact has been growing over the last ten years, shaping the common regulatory framework and facilitating a common supervisory approach. Its role was decisive in circumstances such as the activation of its product intervention powers and the preparation of the European financial services sector for Brexit.

During its first 10 years, ESMA has been a major and relentless driver for more consistent supervision and better regulation of capital markets throughout the EU. ESMA has progressively imposed itself on the forefront of investor protection: addressing issues ranging from profit sharing from securities lending by funds, to closet indexing, to benchmark performance disclosures and performance fees for UCITS funds, to bravely advocating for a no nonsense Key Investment Document for retail investment products, to name a few.





ESMA has become increasingly central in the regulation and supervision of the financial markets, over the last years, holding a pivotal role in managing the prudential and systemic risks that the advent of the global financial crisis has revealed. 2020 has been a transformative year for ESMA, implementing its enhanced mandates under the ESAs Review and EMIR 2.2. In 2021 the change will continue. More central clearing in the EU should lead to more supervisory responsibility for ESMA.
